List of products with anaesthetic in them to soothe or numb the skin

There is a little evidence that using lidocaine when the first tingles are felt can prevent the full-blown symptoms or shorten the subsequent episode [Cassuto J., *Lancet*, Jan 14, 1989. 8629;100-101]. Using these products is your own responsibility - see below

NOTE:

The pharmacist may ask you what you want it for. One of the recognised uses on the paper in the Lidocaine 5% box is "shingles pain." If you are asked "What do you want this for?" you may prefer to answer "shingles"

You are also allowed to answer: "I would rather not tell you," or "It's for my aunt, she didn't say" this last one is particularly useful for the Xylocaine spray.
